Economics Course Placement

Students don't take PUBPOL 810 (Microeconomics and Public Policy-Making) or 811 (Microeconomics Policy Applications) because classes are similar to PUBPOL 303 and PUBPOL 304. Instead students must take one advanced Economics course (from a list of approved courses) in one of the 4 semesters.
